## Our initiatives include


- Deliver the Rapid Reading, Reading Link and Balanced Reading programs to all students.
- Providing support for all students inclusive of children with disability, indigenous and out of home care to achieve a C or better in English, Maths and Science through targeted support (Inclusive practices)
- Providing speech intervention for identified students.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Engaging the services of trained teacher aides to deliver 1:1 reading programs at differentiated levels for all students across the school to reach specific reading goals and improving the frequency of Guided and Rapid Reading programs to build on student decoding and comprehension skills. \$9,000
- Engaging a teacher aide to work with student with diverse learning needs. \$5,205
- Building staff capability to deliver programs, track progress and individualise practices to suit individual student learning styles through case management and professional learning. \$4,923
