- Support students in reaching their P-10 Literacy Continuum Aspects of writing goals.

Our initiatives include

- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year level achievement standards by delivering intensive targeted reading instruction and focus on specific identified strategies through analysis of individual reading assessment and the Literacy Continuum. - Daily Rapid Reading & The Reading LINK-Decoding program 1 :1 (Dr Carol Christensen, 2005).
- Establish effective school processes to build teacher capability in:
 - Moderation processes throughout teaching and assessment cycle.
 - Using data to inform student learning goals and target for reading and writing.
 - Providing one-on-one support for students with disability. (Inclusive practices)
 - Providing speech intervention for identified students.
 - Delivering a balanced writing program to plan and deliver an effective writing programme.
