UNIFORM POLICY

Tiaro State School uniform is worn by students to demonstrate the pride we have in the strong traditions of Tiaro State School.

We are an active school, a school of critical thinkers, eager readers and diverse performers and our dress code reflects these qualities with a casual everyday uniform.

Encouraging your child to take care of their uniform as part of a daily routine will help establish their sense of belonging as they join the Tiaro State School family.

The Tiaro State School Uniform – An Overview

Boys' and Girls' Uniform:

Everyday Uniform

- Two-tone (black/gold) polo shirt;
- Black skort or shorts.

Hairstyles:

- Shoulder length hair or longer is to be tied neatly in a ponytail, braid or bun;
- Hair should be neatly groomed and kept out of the eyes.

Hair Accessories:

- Black and gold headbands, ties and clips

Swimwear:

- Togs (any colour);
- Swim shirt/Rashie (short or long sleeved in any colour);
- Swimming cap (any colour);
- Goggles.

Modification to the dress code:

Parents of students who for religious, cultural or health reasons may need to modify the school uniform are required to make an appointment with the Principal. Staff members will be informed of any student granted a modification to the Dress Code.

Free Dress Policy

For "Free Dress Days", the following rules apply:

- Clothing that exposes the midriff/cleavage/bare shoulders is not to be worn;
- All shirts and dresses must have sleeves;
- Skirts, skorts and dresses must be of a respectable length;
- Clothing must not have inappropriate or offensive language/symbols on them;
- Closed in shoes must be worn at all times;
- A broad-brimmed hat must be worn at all times.

** In the event that a student cannot wear the uniform, please inform the class teacher in writing explaining the temporary replacement of the lost or damaged uniform item.*

Hat:

- Black broad brimmed / Bucket school hat with logo (Sun safety protection);
- No caps;
- Cultural headwear in black or yellow

Footwear:

- Black closed in shoes with black soles. Black laces. No bright logos;
- Consider a sports shoe rather than a formal black leather shoe for practicality;
- Plain white socks;
